POLICY FOR SPECTATORS WITH DISABILITIES

#### INTRODUCTION

It is our aim to ensure there are no barriers to the use of New Countess Park by supporters with any disability, and as such we aim to provide easily accessible information about the stadium's facilities and use. The club are committed to the provisions set out in The Equality Act 2010 and will strive to excel in their commitment.

Access to New Countess Park for wheelchair users and other spectators with any disability is through a designated entrance to the Ground.

#### Wheelchair Access to the Stand

Home Support	From the "Countess Road end" gate, access is level via the gate to the stand. Follow the tarmacadam walkway to designated wheelchair user areas.
	From the "Kellie Road end" gate, access is level via the gate to the stand. Follow the tarmacadam walkway to designated wheelchair user areas.
Away Support	From the "Countess Road end" gate, access is level via the gate to the stand. Follow the tarmacadam walkway to designated wheelchair user areas.
	From the "Kellie Road end" gate, access is level via the gate to the stand. Follow the tarmacadam walkway to designated wheelchair user areas.

#### **Spectators with Ambulant Disability**

There are no specific areas of the ground that facilitate access for the ambulant disabled, however, we are happy to organise seats which can be accessed easily by those persons using crutches, sticks or walking frames.
